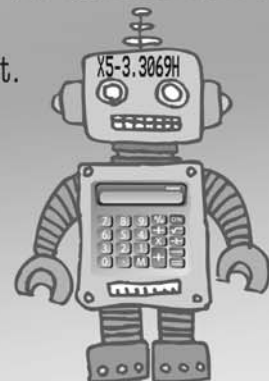

John 11:1,3-6, 17, 20-29, 32,  
34-44

1 Now a man named Lazarus was sick. He was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha.

3 So the sisters sent word to Jesus, "Lord, the one you love is sick."

4-6 When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it." Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. Yet when he heard that Lazarus was sick, he stayed where he was two more days.

17 On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.

20 When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went out to meet him, but Mary stayed at home.

21-22 "Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But I know that even now God will give you whatever you ask."

23 Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."

24 Martha answered, "I know he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."

25-26 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

27 "Yes, Lord," she told him, "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who was to come into the world."

28-29 And after she had said this, she went back and called her sister Mary aside. "The Teacher is here," she said, "and is asking for you." When Mary heard this, she got up quickly and went to him.

32 When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."

34 "Where have you laid him?" he asked.

"Come and see, Lord," they replied.

35 Jesus wept.

36 Then the Jews said, "See how he loved him!"

37 But some of them said, "Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man have kept this man from dying?"

38-39 Jesus, once more deeply moved, came to the tomb. It was a cave with a stone laid across the entrance. "Take away the stone," he said.

"But, Lord," said Martha, the sister of the dead man, "by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days."

40 Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?"

41-42 So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me."

43-44 When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face.

Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go."

When Jesus lived on earth he couldn't physically be everywhere. However, He still knew everything that was going on. He knew that Lazarus was going to be raised from the dead (John 11:4).

Jesus didn't rush over to Lazarus because he needed to show everyone that He was God and He had been sent to save them (v. 40-42).

4. Go out with other friends and learn as a group. Going to church or Youth Group is a great way to hear what others have learned, and to help each other out.

Sometimes it seems difficult to get to know someone who you don't physically see in front of you, but remember God is always with us and does show Himself to us though the things He has created including the people around us.
